



PORTARLINGTON — ST ANDREW’S PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

Congregation formed: 1850s
Other names: St Andrew’s Uniting Church
Location: cnr Fisher & Newcombe Streets, Portarlinton
Opened: October 1873 and 1962
Branch: Free Church of Scotland
Background: The 1873 church has since been replaced with a brick church.



QUEENSCLIFF — ST ANDREW’S PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

Congregation formed: 1850s
Other names: Queenscliff Uniting Church
Location: cnr Hesse and Stokes Streets, Queenscliff
Opened: 31 August 1862
Background: Early services were held in private homes before the church, designed by Nathaniel Billing, was opened in 1862. This was replaced in 1898 by the current church designed by Evander McIver, another Scottish architect from Melbourne.

RUSSELLS BRIDGE — PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

Congregation formed: pre 1854
Location: Russells Bridge
Opened: 1870s
Branch: Free Presbyterian
Background: Early services were held in private homes before the weatherboard church was opened in the 1870s. The former church is now a private residence.



SHELFORD — PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

Congregation formed: c1847
Other names: Leigh Presbyterian Church
Location: Main Road, Shelford
Opened: 8 December 1859
Branch: Church of Scotland
Background: Early services were held at Golf Hill before the current church, designed by Joseph L Shaw, was opened in 1859. It continues as a Presbyterian church after the congregation decided against joining the Uniting Church.
