THIRTY-FIRST ANNUAL REPORT

OF THE

GEEHLONG

Infirmary and Benevolent Asylum,

(Incorporated.)

THE Committee of Management of the above Institution beg to submit, for the information of the Governors and Contributors, their 31st Annual Report. The following persons have received relief, 3254, viz:—

618 In-door patients, (of whom 137 were suffering from accident.)
 143 Inmates of the Benevolent Asylum.
 2493 Out-door patients, (of whom 369 were suffering from accident.)

The usual audited accounts and tabulated returns are herewith presented. The total receipts from all sources, (including a balance of £497 11s. 2d.,) amount to £5784 2s. 1d. The expenditure to £5896 13s. 10d., including over £1000 expended during the year for rebuilding, repairs, alterations, painting, &c. There is a debit balance of £112 11s. 9d., but it must be remembered that only the 1st instalment of £750 has been received from the Government for the year 1882-3; the 2nd instalment is now overdue, and will shortly be paid. It is gratifying to be able to report that private subscriptions, donations, church collections, proceeds of concerts, &c., and municipal grants, have all increased in amount over the last and previous years.

During the past year considerable improvements have been effected in the Buildings, including new and improved ventilation in all the wards, and the alteration of the old defective chimneys, which have been provided with new shafts.

The drainage has also been greatly improved, and nearly the whole of the buildings have been painted, coloured, and renovated.

The gas system throughout has been repaired and enlarged.

The *number* of beds in the various wards has been greatly reduced, so as to give from 1000 to 2000 *cubic feet*, according to circumstances, to each bed; in short, the recommendations of Messrs. Neal and LeCapelain, the Government Inspectors, have been generally carried out, and the Committee believe that the Institution entrusted to their management will now compare favourably with any other Institution of a like nature within the Colony.

In February Dr. Warren sent in his resignation as Resident Surgeon, and Dr. Newman was chosen out of 4 applicants to take his place; at the same time a change was made in the medical arrangements of the Institution. The beds were placed under the charge of the Honorary Medical Staff, and the Resident Surgeon was made subordinate to them.

There have been held no less than 21 Meetings of the Committee of Management during the year; 56 Meetings of the House Committee; 18 of the Finance Committee. Several Sub-Committees were also appointed to consider and report on the alteration of the bye-laws and regulations, and on the recommendations of the Government Inspectors. Those Sub-Committees met frequently, and furnished valuable reports.

The Committee have great pleasure in expressing their gratitude to the gentlemen of the Honorary Medical Staff for the regular and valuable services which they have rendered during the year in the

interests of the Hospital. The Committee also tender their thanks to the Borough and Shire Councils, the Banks, and those Squatters and others in the town and country, who have generously collected and forwarded contributions in aid of the general funds; also to Mrs. Hitchcock, and the Ladies of the *Flower Mission*, as well as to very many others who have contributed weekly, and illustrated papers.

The Committee gratefully acknowledge the sum of £191 15s. 8d. received from the Hospital Sunday Fund, and the sum of £48 collected in the Roman Catholic churches. Their sincere thanks are due to the clergy and others, who have aided in the movement; whereby a considerable amount is raised yearly in aid of the various local charities. Various amounts have also been received on account of Concerts and other entertainments; and the Committee further acknowledge with thanks, donations in *kind*: fish, fruit, &c., which have been generously sent for the use of the Inmates. They are also indebted to the Proprietors of the *Argus*, *Age*, *Geelong Advertiser*, *Times*, *Mirror*, *Ballarat Star*, &c. &c., for gratuitous copies of their valuable journals; and to those ministers of religion and others who have conducted services, and given religious instruction in the Institution.
