[Note: 1851 reference to marriage at St Andrew's Presbyterian Church] Letitia's baptism is recorded but no parents are named, however her death entry shows the correct parents. Henry and Augusta did come to Geelong where their children were born from 1852 to 1871. Twelve members of the extended Warren family emigrated on 'Bombay' arriving Dec 1852. The children William 2, Francis 1 and Mary 1 were all born Cornwall. William jnr subsequently married Jane James. Letitia and James had six children born Kensington [Leopold?] 1872-1881 then four Lara 1882-1884 and one Geelong 1889.

Joanna arrived on the Navarino into South Australia in 1857 with her brother John Levett, her mother Amelia and step-father Robert Hitch (both widowed, Amelia and Robert had married in Ely in 1854). Robert's two sons by his first wife, William and James, were part of the family group. They came to live on the Bellarine Peninsula in 1860. Joanna's early life in Ely was probably fairly difficult. Her father, an agricultural labourer, died when she was a baby, and her mother was described on the 1851 census as a pauper. Robert Hitch was another ag lab and again, this family was almost certainly poor.

Caroline & Thomas arrived at Port Phillip in Dec 1857 on ship "British Trident". JUDD Thomas 32, Caroline 21, (sic) Peter 3. Thomas had previously been married to Caroline's older sister Ann and she was the mother of Peter.* Ann died in 1855.

From Colac group: Thomas JUDD's first wife was Caroline NETHAWAY's sister Anna NETHAWAY who gave birth to Peter 21st Jan 1855 and died the following day.

Thomas married Caroline 31/12/1855.

Thomas Judd, wife Caroline and Peter left England on the "British Trident" sailing from Port Liverpool 14th September 1857. The passenger list records Thomas aged 32 as a gardener, Caroline aged 21 a wife and Peter aged 3, a son. There were a number of other family members on the same ship that arrived at Port Melbourne on 18th November 1857. The family travelled as unassisted passengers and brought a complete cart amongst their luggage and effects. After disembarking at Port Melbourne, the family travelled to Geelong.

Thomas came to the Ondit Plains in 1860 and obtained land under the Nicholson Land Act. The family took up 62 acres on 4th December 1860.

Methodism came to the area in 1862 and the first services were held in Thomas and Caroline Judd's home.
