Unassisted immigrants on the ship "John and Lucy" departed Liverpool 19 Oct 1855, arr Point Henry [near Geelong] 16 Jan 1856: 4 females from Co Antrim, RC, could read and write - possibly 4 sisters

Mary OFFICER, bc1828, domestic servant - went to brother, Melbourne, possibly married Thomas SCOTT in 1858, died 1893 aged 67 in Ballarat, daughter of Robert OFFICER and Margaret McCLURE

Eliza OFFICER, bc1830, needlewoman - assigned to Clement Nash, Kilgour Street, Geelong

Jane OFFICER, bc1831, domestic servant - assigned to Mrs Primrose [sp?], Batesford, married James BALLANTYNE in 1857, died 1891 aged 57 in Ballarat, daughter of Robert OFFICER and Margaret McCLURE

Margaret OFFICER, bc1838, domestic servant - went to brother, Melbourne, married Joseph McCRACKEN in 1867

This possibility - no direct connection with Geelong but may have been visiting extended family in Geelong.

Eliza's mother died in 1865. Her father remarried in 1867 and had further issue still in the Belfast/Tower Hill/Koroit area.

John's brother James OFFICER and his wife Margaret [marr 1866] also had children in the Koroit area with an Eliza born 1878.

The families came from County Antrim, Ireland.

A James OFFICER is buried at Geelong in 1899 aged 34. He was a son of Alex OFFICER and Margaret BOOMER and may have been a cousin to Eliza but nothing else has been traced for him e.g. spouse.

A James OFFICER (born Co Antrim) married Janet / Jane SCOTT in Geelong 1894 and had issue there.

Eliza may have gone to live with extended family members after her mother's death and returned to Warrnambool later.
