The BENNETT family lived at Marlborough Row, Westminster before coming to Australia in 1855 on the "Sea King", landing at Point Henry - Alice, her father, stepmother, sister and step-sister.  
Alice spent her early years in Chilwell.

James Kendle RAWSON owned several blocks of land in the Leigh area. They lived there until abt 1880 when they moved to Geelong and took over the Bayview / Ritz Hotel on the corner of Bellerine and Corio Streets, renaming it the Bayview Temperance Hotel, paying 18 shillings rent a week. They stayed there until the mid 1890s [1891?]. James Kendle RAWSON died in 1904. Alice then lived with her daughter Mrs WORLAND until she died in 1945.

Alice was one of the leaders of the Womens Christian Temperance Union in Geelong. The family story was that Alice tried to keep local cabbies on the straight and narrow. Family history also said that Alice helped get a shelter erected for the cabbies to shelter from the weather.
