Rev John Tait [from Moffat, Dumfries] and wife Elizabeth arrived in Sydney 1837 in response to a call for Presbyterian ministers. They were initially based at Illawarra and then for ten years at Parramatta coming to Geelong about 1850. He was minister of the Free Presbyterian Church in Little Malop St between Yarra and Bellerine Sts. With the growth of the congregation the need for a larger church was evident and a Crown grant was given for this on land in Gheringhap St above Little Ryrie St. A design competition was launched mid 1859 but John died in March 1860 before the completion of this. The church was named High Church but later took the name of St Giles. The building still exists but is no longer a church. The original church became a school, then a ragged school and later a mill until destroyed by fire. John is buried at Western Cemetery. Elizabeth and Annie are in an adjacent grave. Two of the five Tait sons also became Presbyterian ministers with distinguished careers in education, development of the church in Australia and other significant fields.

The signature on this entry is hard to read but is possibly that of Ellen Taylor who is listed in rates as a householder in Gertrude St. No marriage record traced.  
Daughter Ellen [married HILL] born Winchelsea 1879-1923.  
Son John Christopher b Geelong 1882-1927.  
Both died Geelong.  
Nothing definite has been traced of husband John. Ellen is buried in Geelong with her mother Patience Crook c 1806-1896 and brother Christopher Crook c 1836-1906.

Another Ellen Taylor was probably in Geelong at the time of the petition.  
She died Geelong 1903 aged 88 but is less likely to have been head of a household [rate books].

Four sons used HALLS as a given name when marrying. Emma and Jacob had children 1889-1895 and are buried at the Western Cemetery. Jacob's mother, Hannah THEWLIS, Page 3 Line 18, also signed the petition.

This information is believed to be the correct person as Jacob THEWLIS appears on the rates and is the only brother with the initial 'J' who was married at that stage.
