Isabella Vance b Ireland abt 1839, married James Hepburn 1859 [daughter 1861] died 1861 aged 22 Geelong.				
[Mary] Jane Vance b abt 1840 died Geelong 1898 aged 58. Named as ratepayer 1891 and as dressmaker in 1881 directory.				
Isabella and Jane aged 19 and 17 emigrated on Royal Charter December 1856.				
Margaret Vance b abt 1847 died Newtown and Chilwell 1931 aged 84. Margaret aged 16 emigrated on City of Melbourne in 1864. Listed in Keera St 1903.				
Elizabeth Vance b abt 1854 died Geelong 1928 aged 74. Elizabeth aged 20 may have emigrated on Great Britain April 1874 with a W P Vance. May be William John who married 1889 but had different parents.				
Isabella is buried with Jane and Margaret is buried with Elizabeth in the C of E section of Geelong Eastern Cemetery.

Miss Vey, daughter of James and Diana Vey of Geelong, was Secretary of the Geelong City Union for approximately sixteen years, from 1919 until 1935, spanning post-war to Depression times.

She was much appreciated by the Union. In 1924 the members presented her with a very handsome fountain pen, a great surprise. Miss Vey died on 27th June 1944, in Geelong and was honoured as a very old and loyal member.
